(In honor of the founding members of the Northside Hospital-Atlanta Auxiliary)

The Northside Hospital Atlanta Auxiliary has a proud history of awarding scholarships to our Atlanta Campus employees, Auxilians, and their family members. One scholarship per year will be awarded up to \$5,000.

Applicants must be associated with the Atlanta Campus areas where we have volunteer placements:

- Atlanta main campus (including the main hospital, Women’s Center, Tower, Center Pointe and Interchange)
- Alpharetta Medical Campus
- OP at Meridian Mark

and pursuing a career in the medical profession.

Who can apply:

- Current, *active* Northside Hospital –Atlanta Auxilians who have served a minimum of 100 hours in the last fiscal year.
- An employee of Northside Hospital Atlanta (full or regular part time) who has been employed for a minimum of 1 year.
- A child, grandchild or spouse of a *qualified* Auxilian or Northside Hospital-Atlanta employee.
- Applicants can only be awarded this scholarship once, but non-awardees may reapply in a future year.

Scholarship funds:

- May be used for tuition, fees or books for the 2020-2021 academic year
- Will be distributed directly to the institution.
- If unused, scholarship payments will be refunded to the Northside Hospital-Atlanta Auxiliary—not refunded to the recipient.
- Awards are determined by the Scholarship Committee whose decision is final.

Checklist:

- **Official Sealed College or Technical School Transcript** sent from institution (**not** printed from institution’s web page), in a sealed envelope, showing a minimum of a 3.0 grade point average and a minimum of one year of study already completed.
- Copy of Official Written Acceptance Letter—if entering graduate program or transferring schools.
- Verification of tuition amount, this can be printed from the website or your account.
- A minimum of **two, current, original** letters of recommendation must be **signed, dated, sealed** and **sent directly to the applicant** who will include them in the completed packet sent to the Auxiliary. One recommendation should be personal (not a relative) and the other professional. If you are an employee, one letter needs to be from a supervisor.
- Proof of participation in extracurricular activities such as: sports, clubs, arts activities (drama, music, art), student government, job, etc.
- A one page, written or typed essay on why a positive attitude is important to your career goal.

Mail or hand deliver **a completed** application with all of the above included **on or before noon March 13, 2020** to:
